

Italian Culture



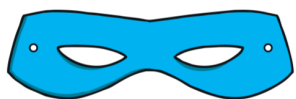
Celebrations are an important part of Italian culture. One way to celebrate is through a carnival. In Italy, the first evidence of a carnival in a city of Venice was in 1094.
