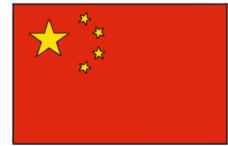




### Chinese Culture

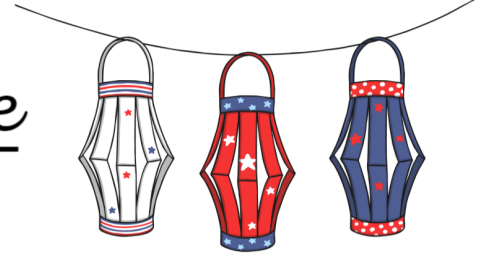
The lanterns symbolise people letting go of the past year and welcoming the new year with good fortune.
